Kansas Buses Go Online with Wi-Fi from SinglePoint Communications

Award-winning Moovbox technology to deliver passenger Internet access on Johnson County Transit

The accompanying MoovManage system enables the JO to monitor and remotely configure multiple Moovbox devices across its fleet, while keeping track of vehicles using in-built GPS functionality. The fleet-wide deployment follows a successful trial in the fall of 2009.

“The JO’s commitment today to expand on-board Internet across their fleet sets a standard for other transport operators to follow,” said Nicole Hawkins, SinglePoint VP. “Furthermore, by underwriting the cost of deployment with revenues from in-hotspot advertising, the JO has demonstrated that there are creative ways of approaching capital cost that benefit passengers while minimizing overhead.”
